SLOCA RECEIVES **\$800 AWARD** FROM THE MISSOURI PAGEANT ALUMNAE CLUB!

On November 29, 2017, the Missouri Pageant Alumnae Club presented SLOCA with an \$800 donation! The Missouri Pageant Alumnae Club is a non-profit organization that sponsors an annual pageant for senior women which fosters their talent, charitable giving, community service and personal growth.



Their main purpose is to sponsor the senior women pageant (women over the age of 60) each July. \$65,000 GRANT HELPS FUND OVARIAN CANCER RESEARCH!

A \$65,000 grant funded by SLOCA has been awarded by the Foundation for Women's Cancer (FWC) to Anindya Dey, PhD, Research Assistant Professor at the University of Oklahoma Health Science Center, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

SLOCA has proudly funded FWC research grants since 2005, awarding over \$364,000 to ten researchers with the goal of mentoring and accelerating the success of young investigative scientists.

The overall goal of Dr. Dey and his colleagues is to develop new therapeutic strategies to effectively treat advanced chemotherapy-resistant cancers, thereby making a difference in the lives of patients affected by

these incurable diseases. Dr. Dey's paper on this research was recently accepted in Molecular Cancer Therapeutics, a journal from the American Association for Cancer Research (AACR).

Dr. Dey obtained his PhD in Biotechnology from the University of Calcutta, Calcutta, India and did a Postdoctoral Fellowship at the University of Florida, Gainesville, FL, and the University of Oklahoma Health Science Center, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

11TH ANNUAL FAMILIES RUN FOR OVARIAN CANCER HITS ALL TIME HIGH!


SLOCA proudly partnered with the Jorgensen family for this year's Annual Families Run for Ovarian Cancer race on October 8th in downtown St. Louis. This was the first year SLOCA managed the race, resulting in one of the largest crowds yet and over 1,500 participants. The 11th Annual Families Run for Ovarian Cancer ROC Star 5k and 1 mile walk/run raised over \$100,000 - the largest amount ever! It was a day of celebrating life, love and the human spirit.

The Jorgensen family started the race in 2007 in honor of their wife and mother, Brenda, as she waged her personal fight against ovarian cancer. Brenda lost her fight with the disease in 2011; however, the race has continued each year in her memory, bringing family and friends together to rally around the women battling ovarian cancer and raising awareness of the early warning signs. All proceeds donated fund ovarian cancer research and support SLOCA's ongoing awareness programs.

Brenda's son, Eric, and daughter, Kristen had this to say about this year's race, "We were able to enjoy the race more than ever. SLOCA 'turned it teal' - it was extremely organized and well-coordinated yet kept the overall feel of honoring and remembering those who have passed from ovarian cancer and celebrating the survivors, their families and friends. Our family has never actually been able to run the race because we have always been coordinating it. But now with SLOCA managing the race, we hope to run next year. Most of all we want to give a huge thank you to SLOCA, the race committee, all the volunteers, the sponsors and all the teams, big and small, that make it such a great day!"



Some highlights of this year's event included the Survivor Ceremony where 70 survivors' names were announced and each received a long stem rose. Julie Tristan, host of Bill & Julie in the Morning on KLOU 103.3, was the Master of Ceremonies, School of Rock provided classic rock music from the main stage, Delta Phi Epsilon from Webster University provided over 25 volunteers and Donna Eversmann, Amy Cambron along with many others donated over 35 gift baskets for the raffle.



There are many teams that come together to run the race. One such team is "Team Jane" honoring Jane Lottes, who lost her battle with ovarian cancer on April 13, 2009. The team consists of Jane's family including husband, Lee Lottes, and her three children, Kristy Hettenhausen, Greg Lottes and Matt Lottes, as well as many more family members, classmates and amazing friends. "We give voice to Mom's story by going all out and making it a celebration of life, honoring all the women we know who have been touched by ovarian cancer," said Jane's daughter Kristy.

"Our team is approximately 100 members strong each year. We have Team Jane t-shirts, a tent, coffee, doughnuts, a catered lunch from Orlando's Catering, games and chalk drawings on the sidewalk for the kids. By participating in the race every year, and honoring our Mom, we are able to support increased awareness of the signs of ovarian cancer leading to earlier detection, increased funding for research and supporting survivors. We have taken an experience of great sadness and tried to turn it into something positive for others."

FIGHT LIKE A GIRL SUPPORTING SURVIVORS

"You are not alone in your cancer journey," is the personal message SLOCA tries to convey through its Sister Box gift to women newly diagnosed with ovarian cancer.

SLOCA distributes about 200 chemotherapy care packages each year to patients across the St. Louis area. Nurses present the Sister Box to their patients at the offices of gynecologic oncologists and at chemotherapy infusion centers, usually at the beginning of treatment.

The boxes are assembled by SLOCA volunteers. Some of the contents are inspirational, some provide comfort and some are just plain fun.

Here's what a few recipients had to say:

"Opening the box brought tears to

my eyes. I know I'm not alone in this journey, but your box lifted my spirits beyond the support from family, friends and community," wrote one survivor.
